## STEWARDSHIP DIALOG

*(a responsive reading of various scriptural passages)*

**Pastor:** This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

**Congregation:** **Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.**

**P:** Who then is the faithful and wise steward, whom the master will set over his household, to give them their portion of food at the proper time?

**C:** **Blessed is that servant whom the master will find at work when he comes. He will set him over all his possessions.**

**P:** Therefore, give and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap.

**C:** **For the measure you give will be the measure you receive.**

**C:** **Each one must do as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.**

**C:** **and may provide in abundance for every good work.**

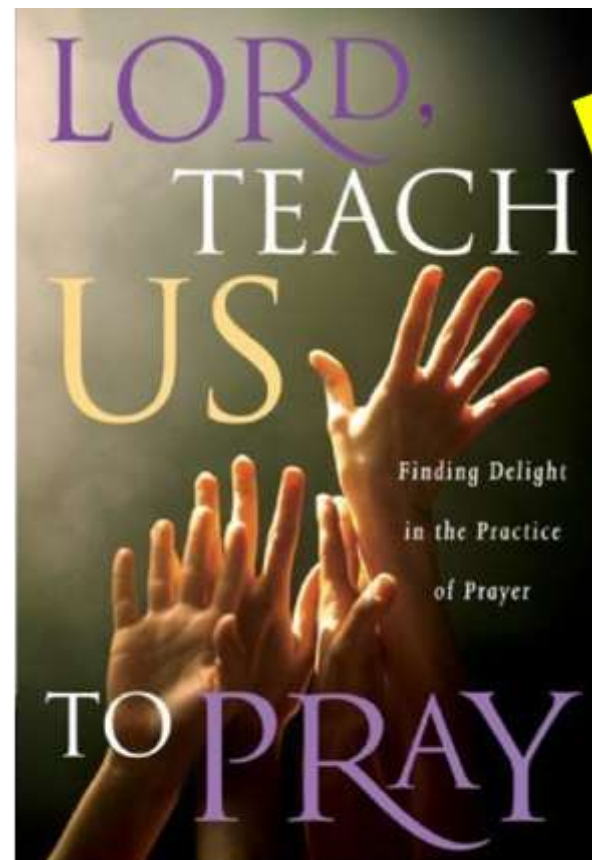
