Brief Order for Confession and Forgiveness:

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1)

P: Most merciful God,

THEME THIS YEAR: "The Adventures of Paul."

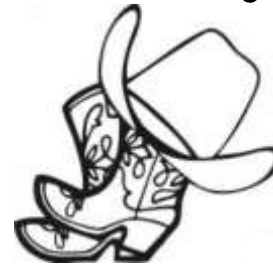
VBS Sunday will be August 7th at the 9:30 am service. The kids will perform what they learned during the week!
