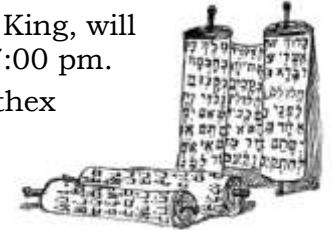
“WORD OF TRUTH”
