Brief Order for Confession and Forgiveness:

P: Be careful then how you live, not as unwise people but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil... Be filled with the Spirit, as you sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, singing and making melody to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks to God the Father at all times and for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. *(Ephesians 5:15-20)*
(brief silence for reflection)

P: Most Holy Trinity,

C: **We confess that we have often been deceived by empty words, and have earned your wrath because of our disobedience. We have flirted with the darkness, and have not walked in your light. Forgive us our sin, and help us to live as children of light, that we may bear the fruit of your light — all that is good and right and true — and help us know what is pleasing to you. Keep us from taking part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead let us expose them to your light. Amen** *(Ephesians 5:6-11)*

P: In the mercy of Almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for you, and for his sake, God forgives you all your sins. As it is written: “Everything exposed by the light becomes visible, and everything that becomes visible is light. Therefore Sleeper, awake! Rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you.” *(Ephesians 5:13-14)*

Song of the Day #25 “By Grace We Have Been Saved”

* Confession of Faith in the Trinity *(from the Athanasian Creed)*

P: We worship one God in trinity, and the Trinity in unity, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the divine being.

C: For the Father is one person, the Son is another, and the Holy Spirit is still another,

P: But the deity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, is one, equal in glory and co-eternal in majesty.

C: What the Father is, the Son is, and so is the Holy Spirit.

P: Uncreated is the Father; uncreated is the Son, uncreated is the Spirit.

C: The Father is infinite, the Son is infinite, the Holy Spirit is infinite;

P: Eternal is the Father, eternal is the Son, eternal is the Spirit;

C: And yet there are not three eternal beings, but one who is eternal,

P: As there are not three who are uncreated and unlimited beings, but one who is uncreated and unlimited.

C: Thus the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God.

P: And yet there are not three Gods but one God.

C: In this Trinity, no one is before or after, greater or less than the other.

P: But all three persons are in themselves co-eternal and co-equal.

C: Therefore, we worship the Trinity in unity, and the one God in three persons.

Summer Church-Crop (Scrapbooking Event) June 25th

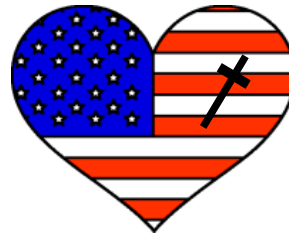

Special Joint 4th of July weekend Worship

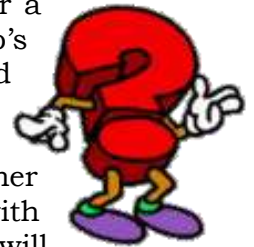

Sunday, 8:00 am service on July 3rd.

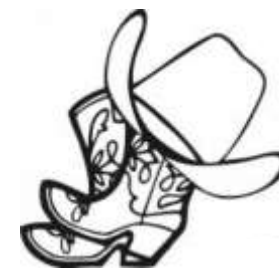
GUESS WHO'S COMING TO DINNER? EVENT JULY 23RD
